- Chocolate Bar Update (Sharon)
 - thank you to everyone helped with this task, it was a daily commitment, this was the last time we committed to running this fundraiser
 - Income was: 26, 990.10, invoice for chocolate 14,000.10, plus approximately 310.00 school day fees
 - revenue approximately 12, 680.00 made 19,000.00 last year (down approx 7500 this year)
 - need to sell the open boxes of chocolate at school events for the remainder of the year, we had 26 open boxes
 - Next fall or spring, the school may be doing their own fundraiser.
- Bingo (Kristin)
 - Cambridge Gaming Association application was approved, the gaming association are stating we most likely will be approved so we should move forward with volunteering training
